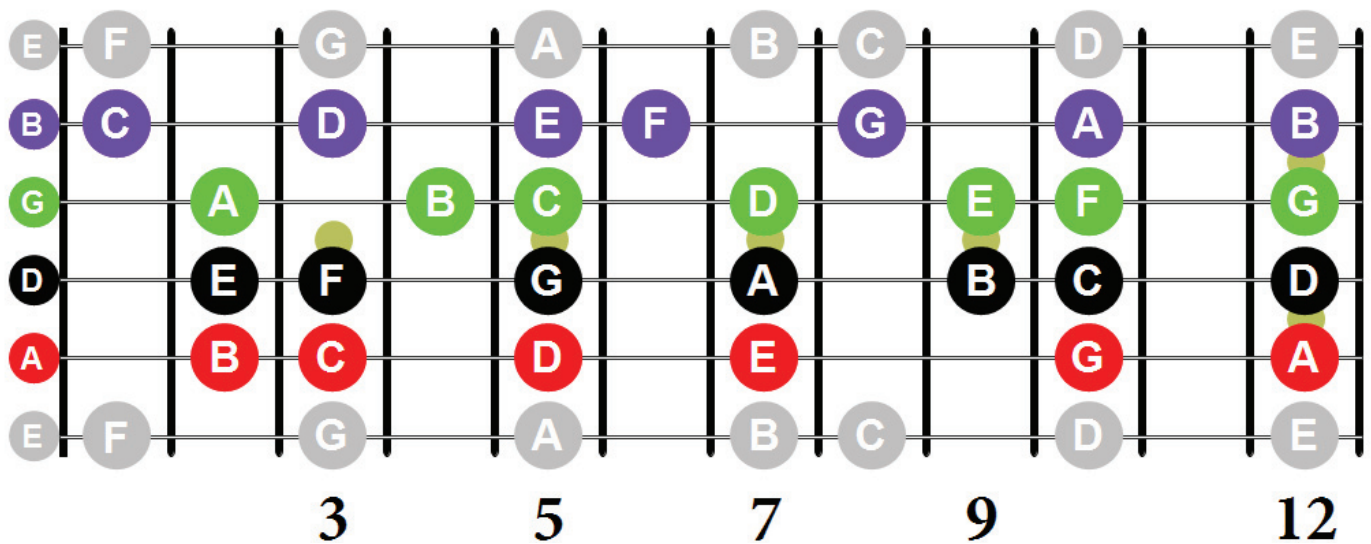


Notes on the fretboard

Now that we know the concept of notes, lets see where the notes are placed on the fretboard.

As we know, the guitar has 6 strings.

1. E - First String (Thinnest and closest to the floor)
2. B – Second String
3. G – Third String
4. D – Fourth String
5. A – Fifth String
6. E – Sixth String (Thickest and closest to the ceiling)



- The notes in the smaller circles on the extreme left are the open strings (played without touching any frets).
- The notes enclosed in circles are the natural notes and their placement on the fretboard.
- The empty spaces are the notes that you have to fill in.
- The numbers at the bottom denote the fret numbers. 3rd fret, 5th fret and so on.

Memorize the position of every note on the fretboard.
